Selection Policy

Selection Policy Aim

The policy aims to select the best possible team to represent the University whilst also providing an additional opportunity for athletes to compete under the university badge.

The competition will be used as an opportunity for freshers to gain experience of a BUCS environment.

Athlete Eligibility

To be considered for selection, athletes must satisfy the following criteria:

- Must have purchased an SU Sport Membership for the current academic year;
- Must have purchased Cardiff Met Athletics Club Membership (done via Cardiff Met SU)

Athletes who are not shown as paid for the academic year at the time of selection will not be considered as part of the selection process.

Competition Format

In 2023, the following events will be contested as part of the match:

Female: 60m, 200m, 300m, 600m, 4 x 200m relay, Long Jump, Shot

Male: 60m, 200m, 300m, 600m, 4 x 200m relay, Long Jump, Shot

Guest places will be available in all events. Athletes will be able to compete in a maximum of three individual events plus a relay.

Selection Criteria and Process

Athletes will be asked for expressions of interest to compete w/c 30th October. An initial team will be selected based on expressions on 13th November.

Initial selections will be communicated on 15th November with confirmation of guest places to be communicated w/c 20th November.

There is no obligation to fill all available positions, however every effort will be made to do so to provide as many opportunities as possible for athletes.

The Track and Field Captains will assist with selection and will be the designated points of contact in relation to team management.
